On September 2, 2005, we sent a mandatory carriage election to you, certified mail, return receipt requested, electing mandatory carriage for Television Station KXLA, Rancho Palos Verdes, California (the "Station") on your systems serving the communities of , California and any other cities, communities and unincorporated portions of the counties served by your systems, which are within the Los Angeles DMA ("Must-Carry Election Letter").

The second paragraph of the Must-Carry Election Letter included a mistaken reference to "KVMD" instead of KXLA. To prevent this mistake from causing any confusion, we wish to clarify and confirm at this time that the Must-Carry Election Letter elects mandatory carriage on behalf of Television Station KXLA, Rancho Palos Verdes, California.

As noted in the Must-Carry Election Letter, KXLA intends to provide its signal to cable systems over-the-air or, where necessary, by alternative means of delivery, in order to ensure that a good quality signal will be received at all cable headends. Please arrange for the member of your staff responsible for engineering issues to communicate immediately with me (Ron Ulloa, President) so that arrangements can be made for the timely installation of any necessary equipment.

As further noted in the Must-Carry Election Letter, the Station requests carriage on cable channel 44, which is the Station's authorized over-the-air channel.
