Forbes looked at cities, villages and towns located within 25 miles of the major city for each of the 15 biggest cities in the U.S., and then chose the top three for each city based on the quality of their schools, crime rates, and income and education levels.

Forbes also factored in home ownership rates during the selection process, claiming that those who own homes are more likely to make efforts to fix their cities problems instead of just packing up and leaving. California children missed 1.9 million days of school and adults missed 2 million days of work due to asthma in 2005.

According to a study by the UCLA Center for Health Policy Research, as many as 475,000 children and adults in California went to an emergency room or urgent care center at least once that year because of asthma. The year 2005 is the latest for which comprehensive health statistics are available from the California Health Interview Survey.

Researchers at the National Cancer Institute have identified a link between inherited and acquired genetic factors that dramatically increase the chance of developing a very common type of melanoma. Knowing who is at greater risk for melanoma due to heredity and understanding the pathways leading to cancer are important steps in addressing MELANOMA.
