Students from around the world recently competed in the 7th Annual International Student ROV Competition. The contest, which is partly funded by the National Science Foundation, asked students to create robots that can perform underwater missions.

Ohio State University glacier expert Lonnie Thompson claims that about 90% of the world's glaciers are getting smaller, but there is one located right here in California that is actually growing. Northern California's Mount Shasta and its seven glaciers have been getting bigger ever since a drought ended in the early 1900s, and the mountain's three smallest glaciers, Konwakiton, Watkins and Mud Creek have more than doubled in length since 1950. Scientists say that the glaciers' growth is due to the Pacific Ocean's warmer waters, which make for more moist air for the mountain that is more than 14,000 feet above sea level at its highest point, and thus more snow.
